- **What does the title of the poem suggest to you?**
  - **What do you think the poem is about?**
  - **Keeping Quiet: Write an article on the benefits of introspection.**
  - **Discussion/debate – ‘Peace of mind leads to success.’**
  - **Read aloud and summarize your views on keeping quite.**
- Keeping Quiet’s summary will enable the students to understand the main theme of the poem.
  - The poet tells us the importance of silence, which helps in understanding each other to develop a better human relationship.
  - Pablo Neruda appeals to us to keep quiet and introspect ourselves to promote a feeling of mutual understanding among all human beings.

Keeping Quiet

5 mins

- **What does the title of the poem suggest to you?**
  - **What do you think the poem is about?**
- In his poem Keeping Quiet, Pablo Neruda appeals to us to keep quiet and introspect ourselves to promote a feeling of mutual understanding among all human beings. He asks us to keep quiet and count up to twelve so that we can introspect ourselves and think of the Earth.

Pair Activity    Make three groups: About poet, About Poem, theme on introspection    10 mins

Give names to the groups and ask the students to write something about the poem.

Writing    1. Write down 5 questions  
Excercise    exercises.....    10 mins

Ask students to write examples on the blackboard.
